- The second part will use a case of direct relevance to Structural Funds and examine the applicability of a particular non-experimental method, giving some hints for further development

He obtained PhD in Economics from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1988 and a Law Degree from the Università di Torino in 1980.

Between 1988 and 1998 he worked for *Mathematica Policy Research* and then for the *Urban Institute* in Washington, DC, specializing in the evaluation of social policy. Since 1998 he is Associate Professor of Statistics and Policy Evaluation at the *Università del Piemonte Orientale* and Director of Progetto Valutazione. In 2001-02 he served as President of the Italian Evaluation Association.
